Minister of Foreign Affairs, Minister of Justice, Minister of Information and Spokesperson of the Palestinian Government

Is General Director and founder of **Panorama Center for the Dissemination of Democracy and Community Development in Palestine**. He was professor at **Birzeit University** over 15 years and member of the steering committee of the **Orient House in Jerusalem**. Active in second track diplomacy and coordinator of the **Arab Program for Democracy promotion and development**.

He is steering committee member of the **World Movement for Democracy**, council member of **Pugwash Conferences on Science and World Affairs**, which is a Nobel Peace Prize recipient in 1995, and of many other regional and international networks and organizations. He is recipient of **European Peace Prize in 2000** in Copenhagen, **Democracy Courage Award in 2004** in South Africa, and **Italian Peace prize, Lombardi region in 2005**.

He is the author of weekly article in **Al-ayyam newspaper** in Palestine, and author of chapters of books, including “**The list of prospective Palestinian inquiries: the hundred questions list**” and “**the Custodianship**” *The Role of Third Party in Palestine* (Palestinian Strategic and Policy Studies Center, 2006), and “**the Palestinian elections: Beyond Hamas and Fatah**” (Journal of Democracy, July 2006, Volume 17, Number 3).
